 - ii. At home?

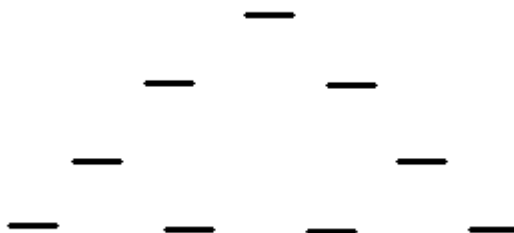
